Over 9, 000 of these women and young girls were sent north to Newcastle, Maitland, and further up the Valley for their assignments.

Our **Female Convict Bonnet Project** is part of the **Christina Henri's "Roses of the Heart"** Project which she started in Tasmania. We are paying tribute to these remarkable and courageous women, who were the "founding mothers" of this colony, by making a bonnet for each and sharing their stories.
